8.1 **Update on problems already reported to SGC unless stated.**

A meeting is due to take place with Boyd Valley councillors re the dangerous condition of Culleysgate lane with the request to install "No through road Signage" along with a water depth mark pole on the Doynton-Dyrham lane.

The blocked drain by Vine cottage on the junction with Bury Lane and High Street in Doynton, continues to be chased by Boyd Valley Cllrs. Stokes and Palmer.

The blocked culvert on Watery Lane/Tog Hill Lane has been unblocked.


Repairs to several Potholes on Rookery Lane are awaiting a dry spell of weather.
